Maintenance:

W. West Street trailer

Residents in town have concerns with the fire damaged trailer. Saltsman Sr. made a motion to have Town Attorney to draft a letter to mail owner, second by Council Member Harwood.

Catholic Church

National and Ridge Street tile replacement

Old Business:

Contract extension for Republic Services

Saltsman Sr. made a motion to accept the new proposal in the amounts of **\$14.50 for 2021, \$14.79 for 2022, \$15.09 for 2023** with Republic Services contract extension, second by Council Member Harwood.

Motion was carried with a vote of 3 yes 0 no.

Invoice #9506-Fire Department

Fire Department recently requested that the town help with the invoice and to cover half of the survey/testing fees. Town Council had declined to pay the invoice. Town Council Member Harwood made a motion to donate **\$500** to the White Post Fire department, second by Council Member Wilcoxon.

Motion was carried with a vote of 2 yes 1 no.

Community Foundation of Pulaski County

Wendy Rose was interested in gaining the Town's support for the Foundation's proposal. Funds have been spoken for the remaining 2020 budget year. Council Member Harwood suggested we can look over the excess for 2020 and if there is excess, the Town can then donate.

With nothing further to discuss, Council Member Harwood made a motion to adjourn the August 2020 monthly Town Council meeting, second by Council Member Saltsman Sr.
