The Town of Medaryville held a public hearing to provide interested parties an opportunity to express their view on the proposed federally funded CDBG project. Executive Director of KIRPC, Edwin Buswell was present to answer questions on the intentions of the Town to apply to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs for a grant from the State Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Wastewater/Drinking water Program. These funds are to be used for a community development project that will include the improvements to the town's water system.

There were no interested parties, Council Member Saltsman Sr. made the motion to close the Public Hearing, second by Council Member Schultz.

Second reading of 2019 Salary Ordinance:

**New Business:**

Property owner Cheryl Stone approached the Council with a request to eliminate drainage water in her storage area and carport.

Maintenance Supervisor Hauptli responded the area is too wet but when it dries the Town is intending to dig up the area possibly after the holiday week and if weather is permitting to jet the tile.

Mrs. Stone also asked when Christmas lights will be placed through the Town. Maintenance Supervisor Hauptli does not like seeing the lights before Christmas but will promptly place them the week after Thanksgiving.

Council Member Saltsman Sr. discussed installing a street light in the area of Pearl and Waldron alley.

Maintenance Supervisor Hauptli addressed the Council with his concern why the Town would pay for a security light that would cost an additional \$16 a month. Where does the Town draw a line on homeowner's responsibility? The area has no traffic to justify a street light and if the Town installs a security light then others will want the Town to pay for their security lights also. No action was taken by the Council in regards to the light.

Council President Schultz asked for an update on the Pulaski Memorial invoice. Another letter was received stating the account will be sent to a collection department and requesting a response within 10 days of receiving the letter. Town Attorney Lapaich advised Clerk Treasurer Harwood to resend the letter requesting them to contact her.

With nothing further to discuss, Council Member Saltsman Sr. made a motion to adjourn the November 2018 monthly Town Council meeting, second by Council Member Schultz.
